



Fuqua Middle/Upper School Lunch Purchase Program

Fuqua School students may pay for items purchased in the lunch room with cash or through the school's debit card system.

Questions

1. How can I set up a debit card account?

All students enrolled at Fuqua School are assigned an identification number. Debit accounts are activated with the first deposit for parents wishing to participate in the debit card system.

2. How do I make deposits?

Simply send cash or check to Fuqua Upper School lunch room.

3. How much should I deposit into my child's account?

The following information should be helpful to you in estimating the amount to deposit:

- ~ A typical breakfast costs \$2.75 per day; a typical lunch costs \$4.50 per day.
- ~ Breakfast is served 180 days per year; lunch is served 175 days per year.

4. What if my child's account does not have enough money?

If an account has a negative balance over \$10, a daily balance report and payment notice will be mailed out the 3rd week of each month. Parents will also be called by Linda Shepherd, Middle/Upper School Food Services Supervisor. If an account reaches a \$30 negative balance and no payment is made within the 30 day cycle, parents will be called to see if any payment can be made. If no payment is made by the end of the next 30 day cycle, a \$25 over limit fee will be added. A call will also be made by the Director of Operations to the parents to notify them of the fee and inform them that charging privileges could be revoked if the account is not made current. 5. Can my child charge if I have not activated a debit card account?

While charging is strongly discouraged, the school recognizes that children sometimes forget their money and have to charge. If this happens, the parent should send money to cover the charge the following school day to the Upper School lunch room.

6. What are the benefits of the debit card system?

The debit card system eliminates the need for students to bring cash to school. Through the system, parents can 1) limit how much their child spends daily, 2) limit what items their child may purchase, and 3) receive information regarding what items their child has purchased. 
